

Junior Elite Lyrical Rhinestone Instructions

Junior Elite Lyrical Routine – Taupe leo with black lace and taupe skirt

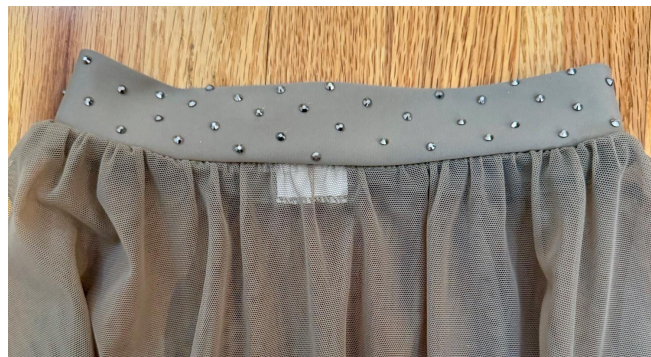
Materials Provided:

- 4 gross Hematite 16ss
- 2 gross Hematite 12ss

Materials you need to provide:

- Rhinestone glue (recommended E6000)
- Glue Applicator/Syringe
- Rhinestone Applicator
- Parchment or wax paper (to protect surfaces and prevent glue from soaking through layers of costume)

Step 1: Stone the waistband of the skirt

You will use 16ss stones in a scatter pattern on the waistband of the skirt. The stones should be in triangle patterns roughly $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch apart as seen in the photo below. Penelope's waistband is 20" total and used approximately 75 stones. Don't place them closer together than $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch and try to keep it "patternless". Also, I would strongly suggest stoning this entire costume on a pillow or with a form behind it so that it lays nicely.



Step 2: Stone the Straps

You will use 16ss stones on your straps and they'll be placed pretty close together. You should have 6 stones per inch. Start at the front and go to the back, doing your best to end without a "gap".



Step 3: Stone the flowers

Below are various pictures of the flowers on the lace on the leotard. Every flower gets stones. The vines and leaves do not. In the pictures with the dots, BLUE dots are 16ss (larger stones). PINK dots are 12ss (smaller stones).
