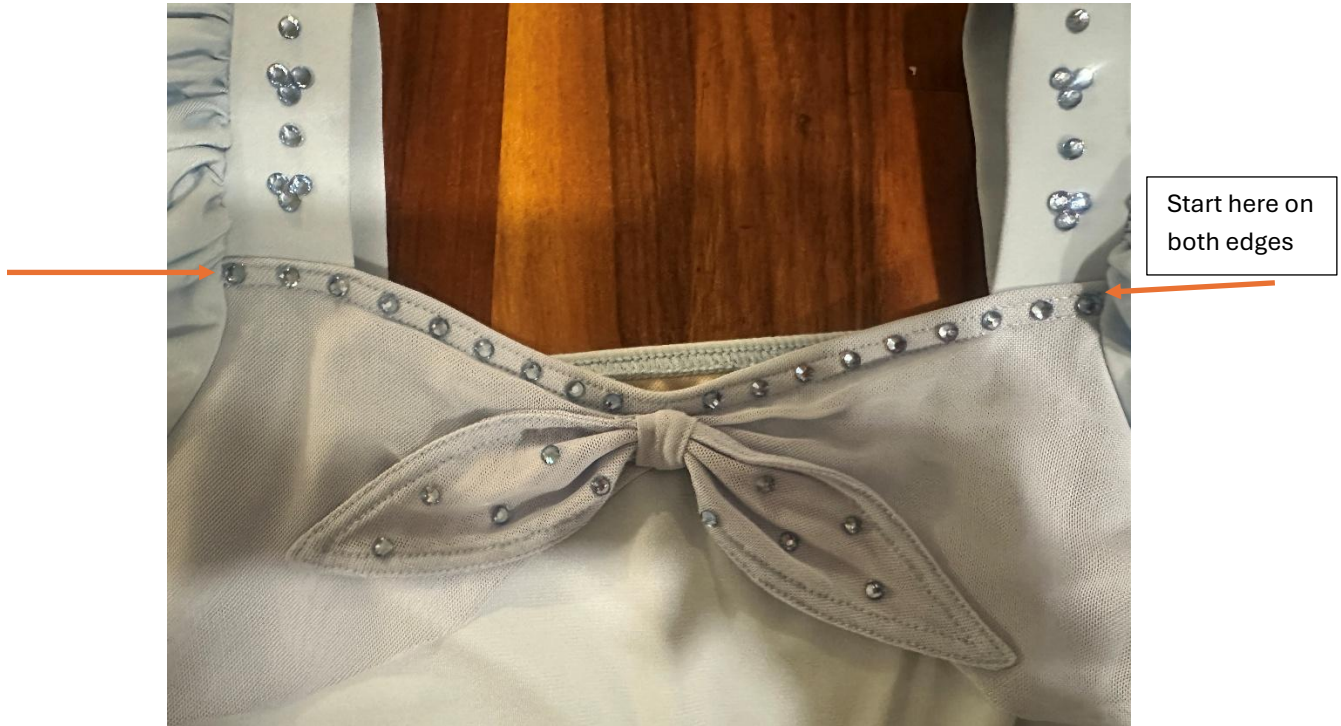


Junior Elite Sp. Lyrical Rhinestone Pattern

Items Received: 1 Pack of Light Sapphire 20ss Rhinestones

Step 1: Front Neckline

1. Starting from the outside edge, place 1 stone every ½ inch on the front neckline until you reach the center bow.
2. Repeat from the other edge.



Step 2: Front Bow

1. Scatter 4-5 rhinestones on each side of the bow on the front of the dress. Pattern does not matter.

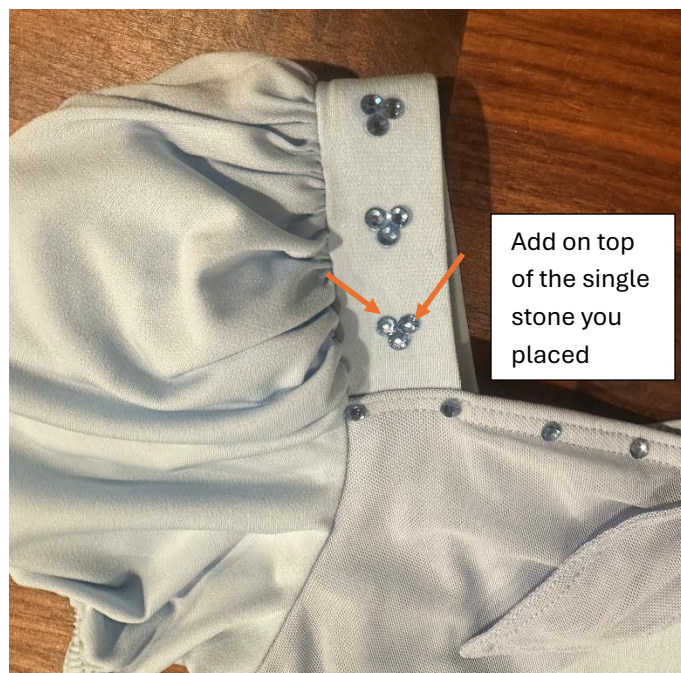


Step 3: Straps

1. Start on the front of the dress. Place your first stone about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch up from the seam of the strap. Stone should be placed in the middle of the wide shoulder band.
2. After placing your first stone, place another stone every 1 inch on to the back (you may have to let the front dry first)



3. Once a rhinestone has been placed every 1 inch on each strap, go back and add 2 stones above each individual rhinestone. They should make a triangle with 3 stones and all be touching.



4. Once you have completed all your triangles, add 1 single stone evenly spaced between each triangle, from the front to the back.

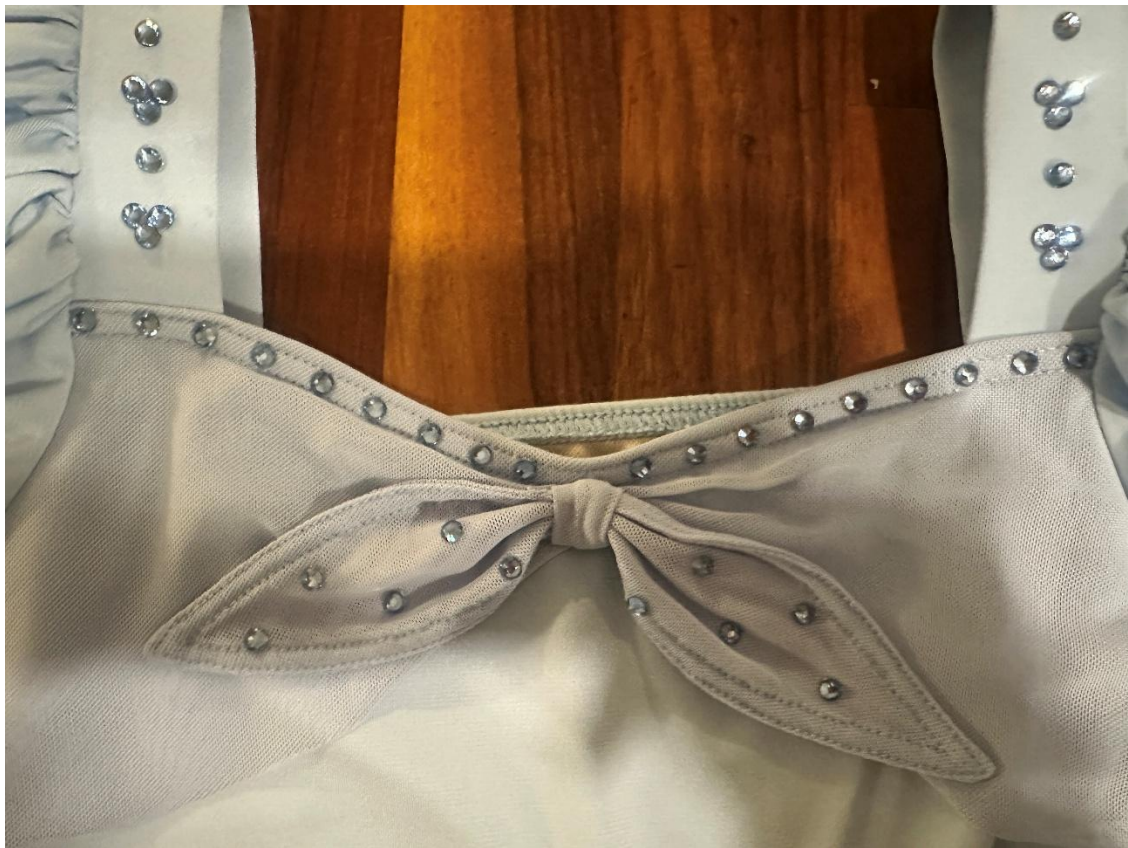


Step 4: Back Neckline

1. Just as in the front, start at the edge and place 1 rhinestone every ½ inch across the back neckline

Step 5: Hairbow

1. Scatter 4 rhinestones around each side of the hairbow.



Step 6: Skirt

1. You can start on the front or back of the skirt; it won't make a difference. Lay out the skirt as wide as you can and place parchment paper under where you are rhinestoning. Be sure to have the parchment paper under the skirt through this whole process or you may end up gluing your costume together.



2. You are going to rhinestone both layers of ruffles. You can start on the top or bottom layer. Your first row is going to be right above the seam of the ruffle. Start at the side seam of the dress and place a rhinestone. Rhinestones will be spaced 1 inch apart.



3. Repeat this pattern on the bottom ruffle as well – front & back.
4. Once you have placed all the rhinestones above both ruffles, front & back, you will place a row of rhinestones below the seam of each ruffle. Stones should be placed about $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ inch below the seam. The stone can be placed in-between the stones in the row above it.

Note: As you work through the 2nd row on each ruffle, don't worry about exact placement every $\frac{1}{2}$ inch or a perfectly straight line. With the ruffles folding, it will look more scattered when it's on.

Additional Note: When you do the top ruffle, be sure to place the parchment paper on the top of the skirt, under the ruffle you are rhinestoning.



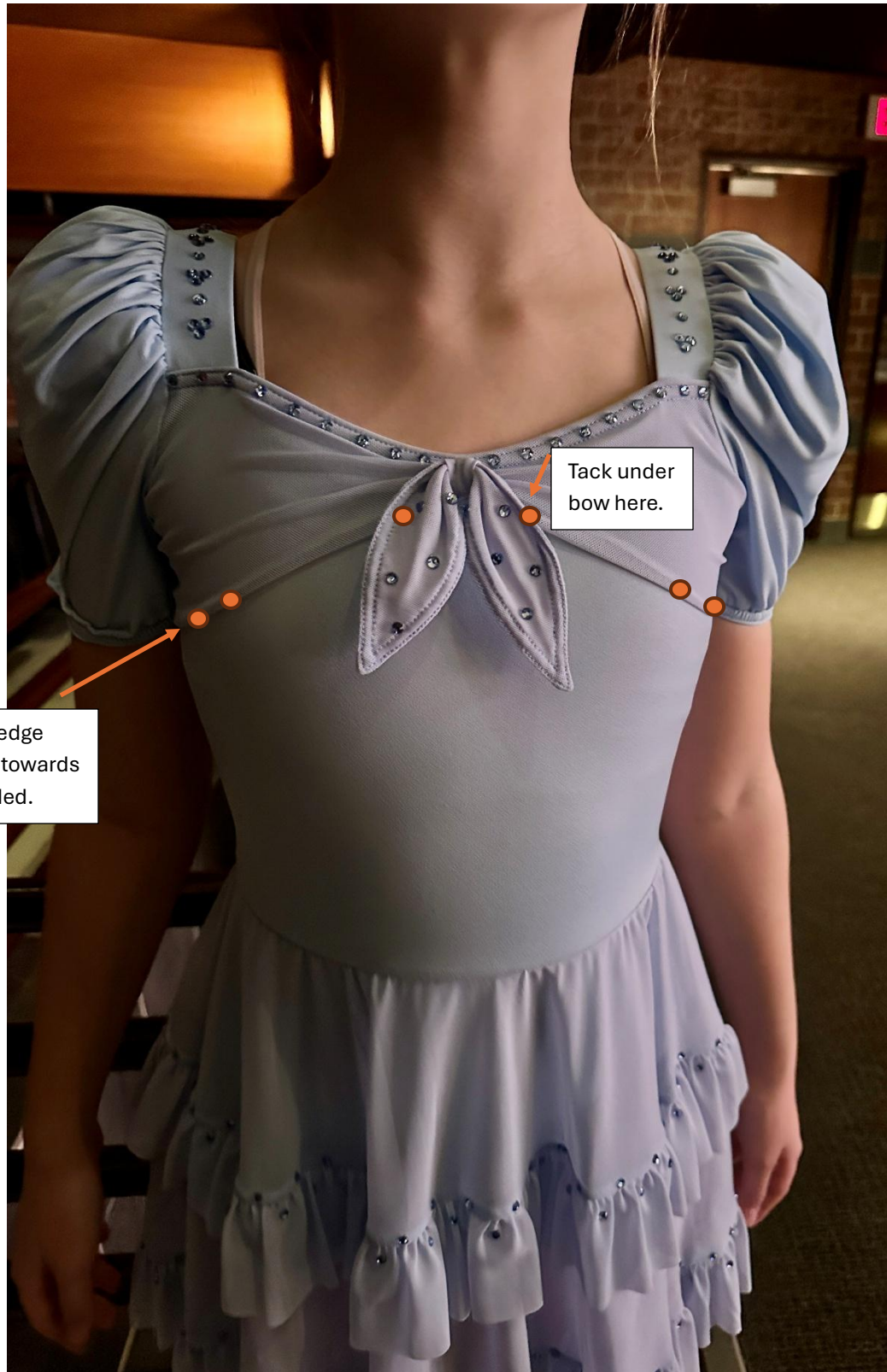
5. Repeat on each ruffle front & back

Step 7: Tack mesh on top to costume

1. A number of the girl's mesh over their chest, rolls up or sits funny above their chest. Have your daughter put on the costume. Pull the mesh part down and using glue or a small tag gun attach the mesh to their costume. Try attaching at the sides, closest to the armpit and then under the bow first. If that doesn't work to hold it, you can add additional secured spots starting from the outside in.
