

Petite Jazz (Girls only)

Teal and neon green biketard with sequins and fringe and scrunchie

Supplies

20ss Bermuda Blue

20ss Meteor

Glue/Adhesive (E6000 recommended)

Glue applicator or syringe

Wax-tipped applicator

Wax paper or similar to prevent bleed through

Instructions

For general instruction on how to rhinestone, check out the guide provided on the MDA website. You can find it on the Team Families page. There is a tab for costume patterns and if you click on the Petite link, you will find the guide as well as all the costume patterns.

Green Belt

We will be stoning a scatter pattern onto the green belt area with the 20ss Meteor stones, both front and back (approximately 60 stones)

1. Take approximately 60 Meteor stones (try to save around 6-8 stones for the scrunchie) and split them into two piles, one for each side of the belt. The piles don't have to be exactly even but you will try to put around 25-30 stones on each side. Further split one of the piles in half again (so there are around 12-15 stones in each pile). These will be for the front side of the belt.
2. Starting with the front, take 1-2 stones from each of the "front" piles to place in the center of the belt buckle area. Place these 2-4 stones inside the area framed by the belt buckle in a "random" pattern/location



3. In a very loose "zig zag" pattern place about 12-15 stones all over the right side of the belt working out towards the right edge. If you have a smaller kid, shoot for around 12-13

stones and if your kiddo is bigger, shoot for closer to 150. This is meant to look random, so don't worry if some stones are a little closer or a little farther away from another.



4. Repeat step 3 with the other side of the front belt



5. Give that side a few minutes to dry so your hard work doesn't get messed up!
6. Repeat step 3 with the other side of the belt, this time using around 25-30 stones across the whole back side. Use a loose "zig-zag" pattern if it helps you feel more comfortable spreading them out evenly



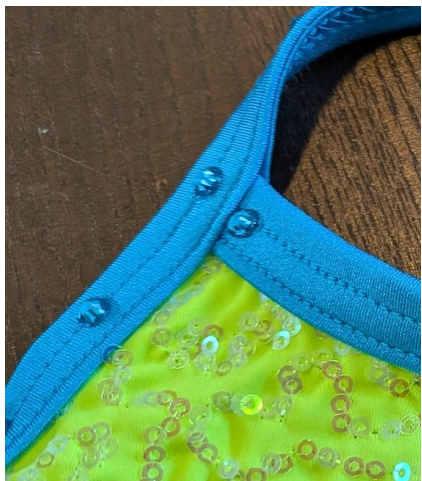
Blue Straps

We will be stoning a line along the blue straps with the 20ss Bermuda stones.

1. I started with a strap where it meets the back trim. And placed a stone on the strap just above that intersection. Place a stone every one inch, following the trim all the way around and back down the other back strap. Only the center front of the blue trim won't have stones when you are finished. I was able to use my thumb as a spacer as it gave me the 1 in spacing I was looking for.



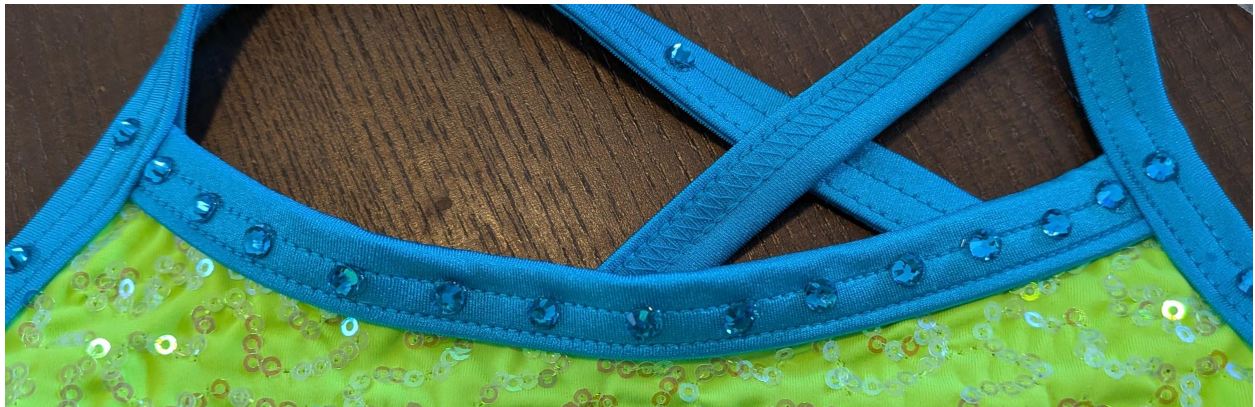
2. We are going to put the stones closer together along the center front. Start by putting one stone at each end, very close to where the center front trim intersects with the straps



3. From there, place a stone in the center, and then one stone on each side, evenly spaced between the edge stone and the center stone



4. Fill in the area between these spaced stones with 2-3 stones so that the spacing between the stones ends up around 1cm to ½ in (I used my pinky finger)



5. If you find you need more stones, please reach out and we can get you a few extra!

Scrunchie

We will be stoning a little sparkle onto both sides of the scrunchie with a combination of the Meteor and the Bermuda stones you have remaining. (6-8 Meteor and 20-24 or so Bermuda)
Please reach out on Band if you need more stones!

1. Split your Meteor and Bermuda stones into two piles so you have an even number of each color for each side of the scrunchie
2. Place 3-4 Meteor stones approximately evenly around one side of the scrunchie
3. Scatter 2-4 Bermuda stones in between each of the Meteor stones in a “random” pattern



4. Give that side a few minutes to dry so your hard work doesn't get messed up!
5. Repeat steps 2 and 3 with the other side of the scrunchie

All done! You did great and everything looks amazing!
