

Junior Tap Costume Update Instructions

Materials provided:

Bag of red feathers and 1 red flower

Materials you need to provide:

Rhinestone glue (Recommended E6000)

Glue applicator/syringe

Tap costume

Our mission is to add a red flower to the tap costume and red feathers to the tap headband!

Step 1: Glue the flower to the tap costume

You'll apply E6000 glue to the back of the flower (the white felt) and glue the red flower to the costume in approximately the same place as the photo below. We suggest having your dancer put their costume on, and placing the flower per the photo below. We purposely did not provide exact measurements as everyone's body shape and costume sizing is different, but we want them to look similar, so use your best judgement!



Step 2: Glue red feathers into the tap headband

You all have a bunch of red feathers. We did NOT sort through them. **You are ONLY going to use 1 or 2 of them – just enough to give it a pop of red color**, but we didn't want to spend time sorting through or picking out the "cute" ones and we wanted to make sure you had extras in case you lost one during the season! We don't want the extra back!

You'll pick out the feathers you "like", and then you'll place some glue on the tip of the feathers and glue them into the back/base of the headband. **The GOAL is to have them give a POP of color, so don't blend them too much, but also to have them look like they were always part of the headband!**
