

Tap- Pink gingham costume

20ss Lilac stones- 124 stones total

Measurement between all stones in 1 inch.

Stone Allotment

Buttons 24 stones total- 4 stones on each button

Bib- vertical white border outside of buttons, down torso- 12-14 Stones

Collar- 50 stones

Belt- 36 stones



Stoning Instructions-

1. Start with the buttons. There is no measurement used here. When finished the stones should be arranged in a square formation on the white button with small spaces between stones resembling a button. I put a towel under both sides of the button when stoning so that the buttons stood straight.



2. The collar will be outlined around the entire costume. Start at the collar on the front of the costume where the collar forms a V. Place a stone at the top of the V, the bottom of the V, and then center a stone between the top and bottom stone. From here I laid a tape measure on the collar and dropped a dot of glue every 1 inch mark on the edge of the collar. Stoning can be done doing the top and bottom at the same time or individually. This will continue around the entire costume.



3. The belt will be stoned around the entire costume on the top and bottom of the belt. Start at the left seam on the front of the costume, lay the tape measure out and drop a dot of glue every inch on the top of the belt
4. For the bottom of the belt the stones will be offset 1 inch. Lay the tape measure on the belt and drop a dot of glue every inch in the window of the top of the belt stones around the entire costume.



5. Bib- two vertical lines on the outside of the buttons place a stone right under where the costume collar lays. Then drop a dot of glue every inch until the top of the belt.



Jazz- Hawaiian Floral with Ruffle Butt

20ss Pixie stones- 140 stones total

Measurement between all stones on *front* of costume ½ inch

Measurement between all stones on *back* of costume 1 inch.

Stone Allotment

Leg- front ONLY 24 stones

Shoulder Strap- 10 stones

Front Collar- 24 stones

Back Collar- 12 stones

Back Cut Out- 24 stone

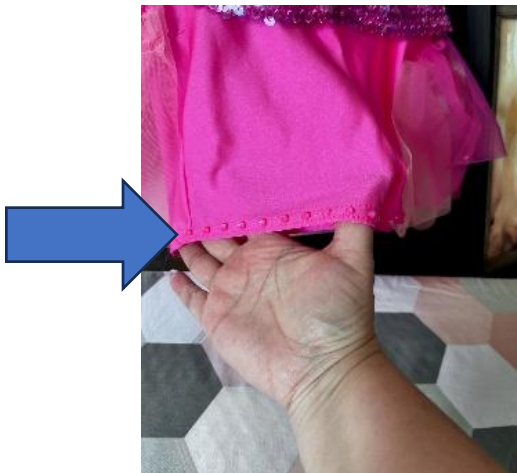
Ruffle Sleeve- 15 stones

Butt Ruffle- 30 stones



Stoning Instructions-

1. Lay front of costume on a flat surface. Tuck butt ruffles up for legs to lay flat. Drop a dot of glue starting at outside seam of each leg. Lay measuring tap at seam start and drop a dot of glue every ½ inch until the inside leg seam is reached. Stones should be placed inside of seam lines. ONLY on the front.



2. Top *front* of costume (move ruffle back to over butt) lay flat. Start at the left side seam on pink collar drop a dot of glue. Lay measuring tape out and drop a dot of glue every $\frac{1}{2}$ inch until the shoulder seam is reached. Again, stones should go in between the stitch lines (center of collar). Only do this spacing on the front.



3. Shoulder strap- lay flat and drop a dot of glue every $\frac{1}{2}$ inch from the front to the back of the strap in the center of the strap.



4. Lay back of costume flat. Starting with the back collar find the last stone from the front either side of the costume as starting point. Lay tape measure out and drop a dot of glue every 1 inch until the other front stone is met.



5. Back cut out- drop a dot of glue in the center of the pink banding. Lay tape measure out and drop a dot of glue every 1 inch until the entire cut out is lined.



6. Ruffle butt- place a piece of wax paper, paper towel, or towel to keep the top ruffle separate from the bottom ruffles. If not separated the glue will seep onto under ruffles. Scatter the remaining 30ish stones across the top ruffle.



7. Ruffle sleeve- place 15 stones scattered throughout the ruffle – front & back.
